
## Using XtreamLab's SnappyMail service

Visit <u>https://snappymail.xtreamlab.net</u> and login using your XtreamLab mail mailbox name with *@xtreamlab.net* appended and your password, for example, if your mailbox were *mymailboxname*, then you'd login thus:



First time you're in you should set up your email address and signature, so to Settings on the top right menu:



Go to Accounts and Add an Identity:
